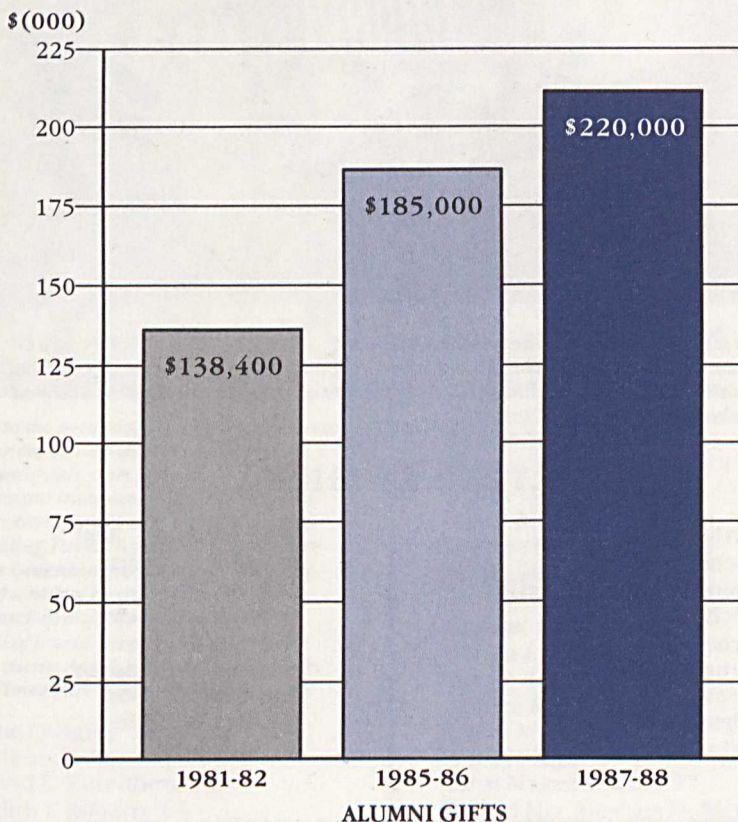
The goal of the 1987-88 Advocates Campaign is to raise \$220,000. Our objective is to make scholarships available for students with demonstrated merit and need.

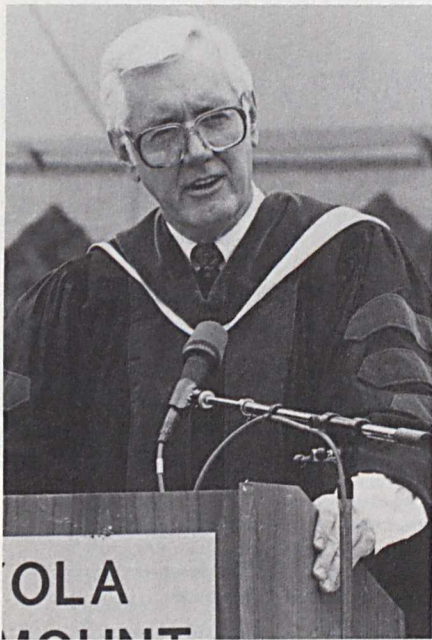

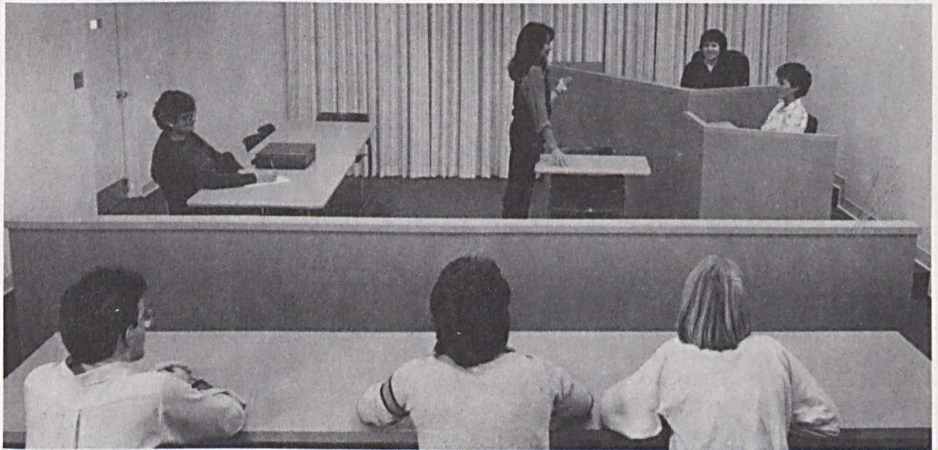
