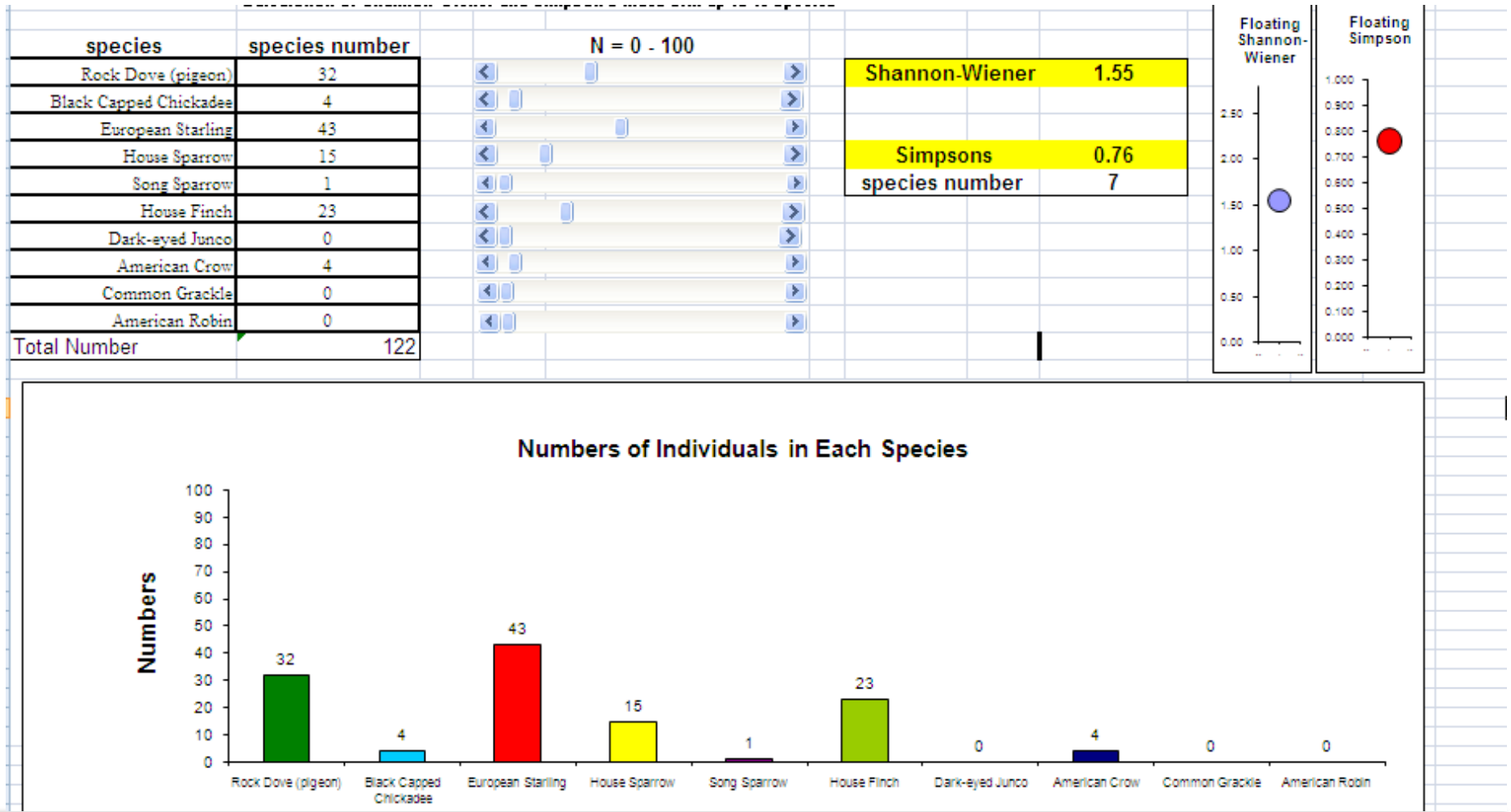

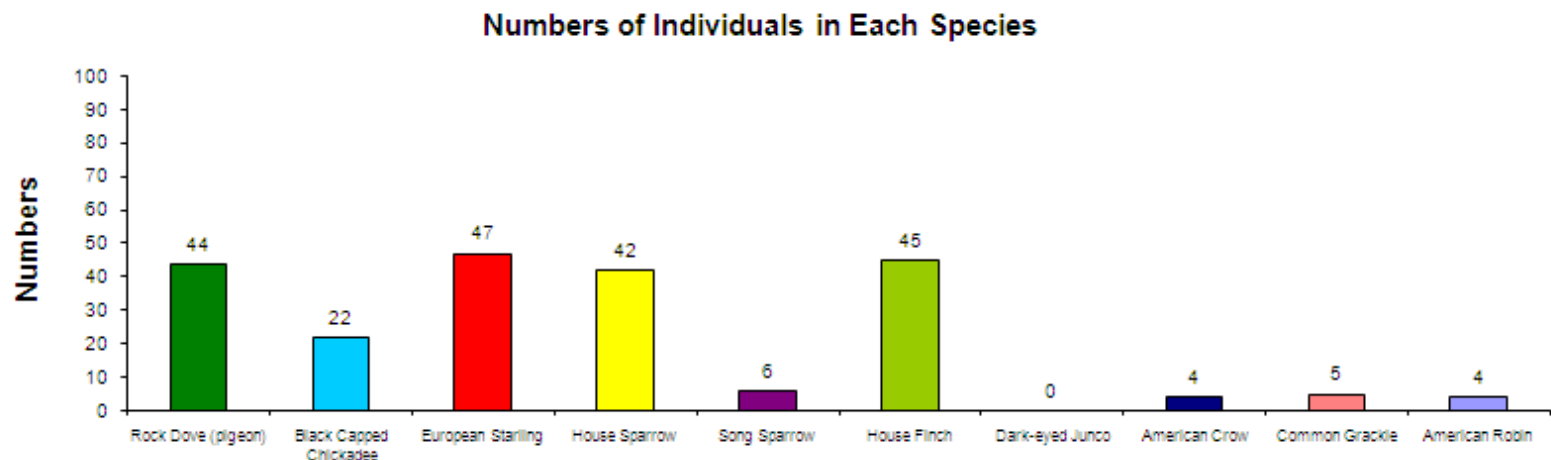
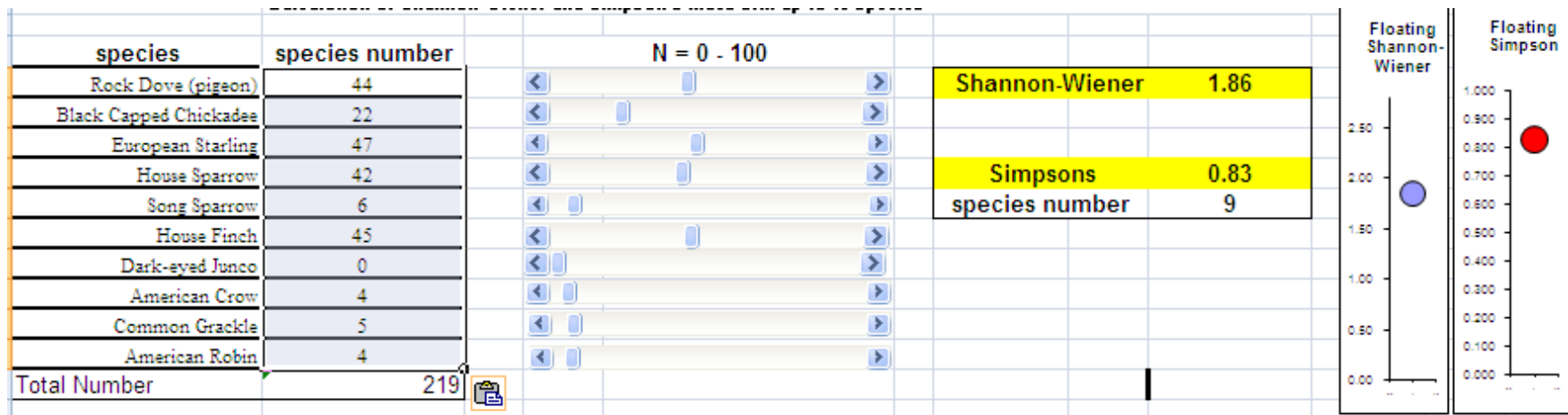
Scenario 1:
