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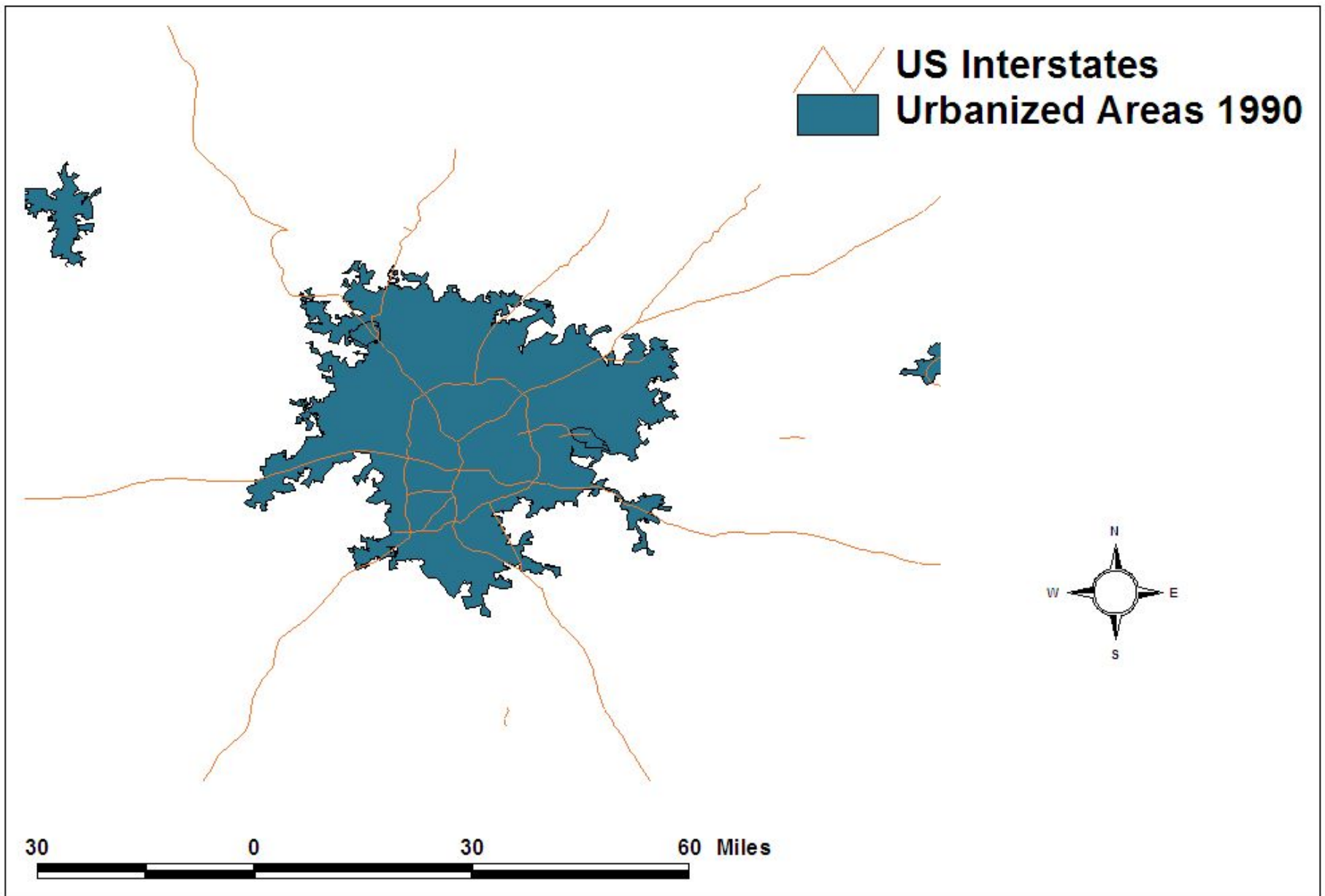
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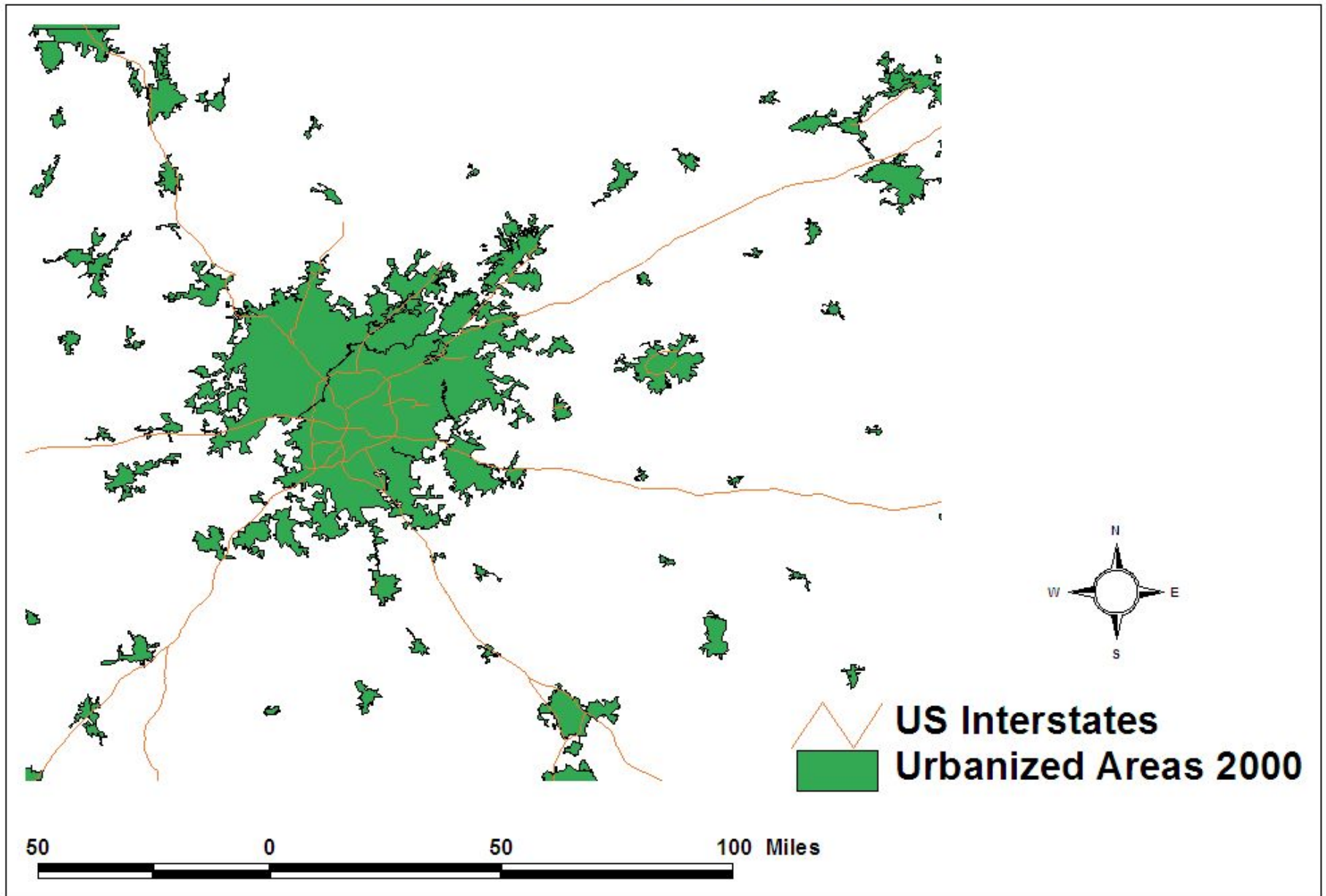

Atlanta Growth (1990-1999) and Land Use Patterns

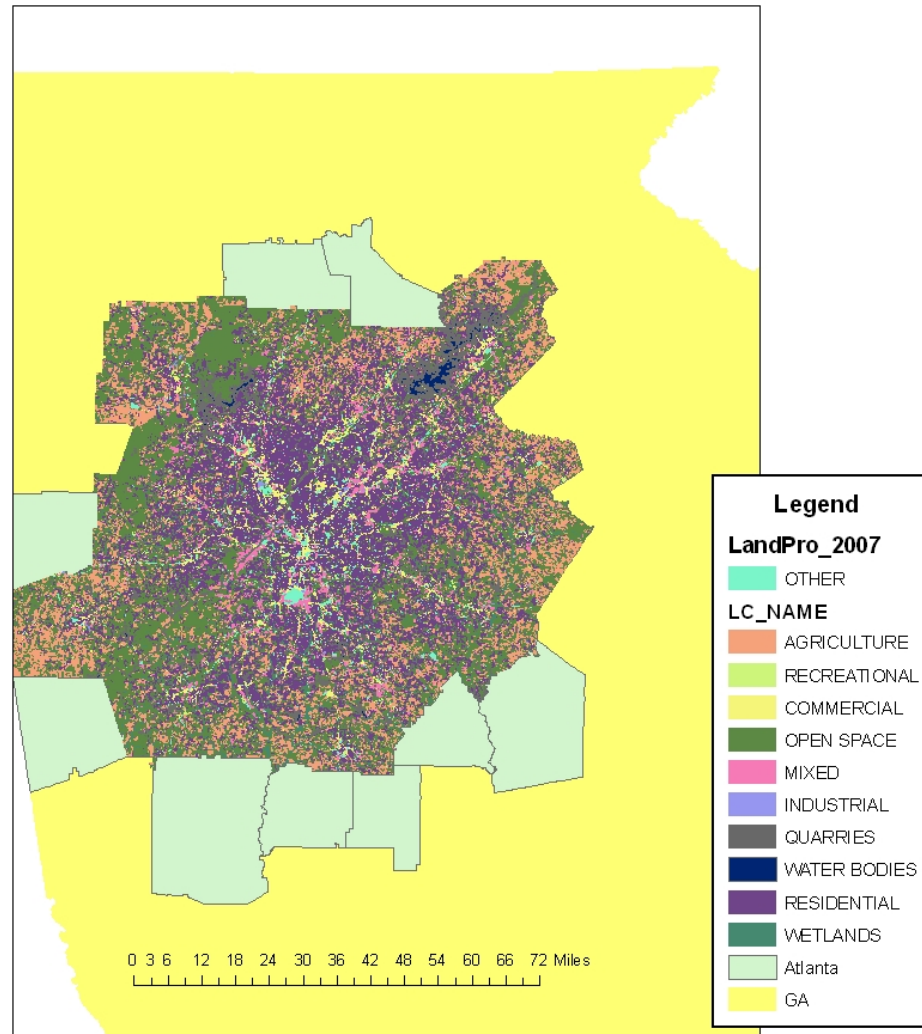
Atlanta Urbanized Area 1990



Atlanta Metropolitan Area 1999

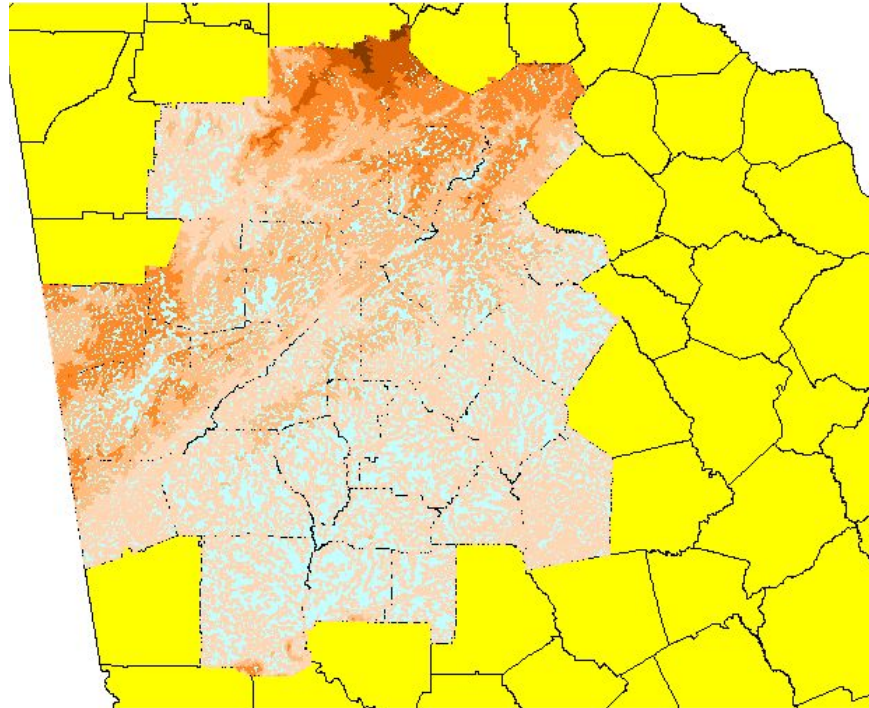

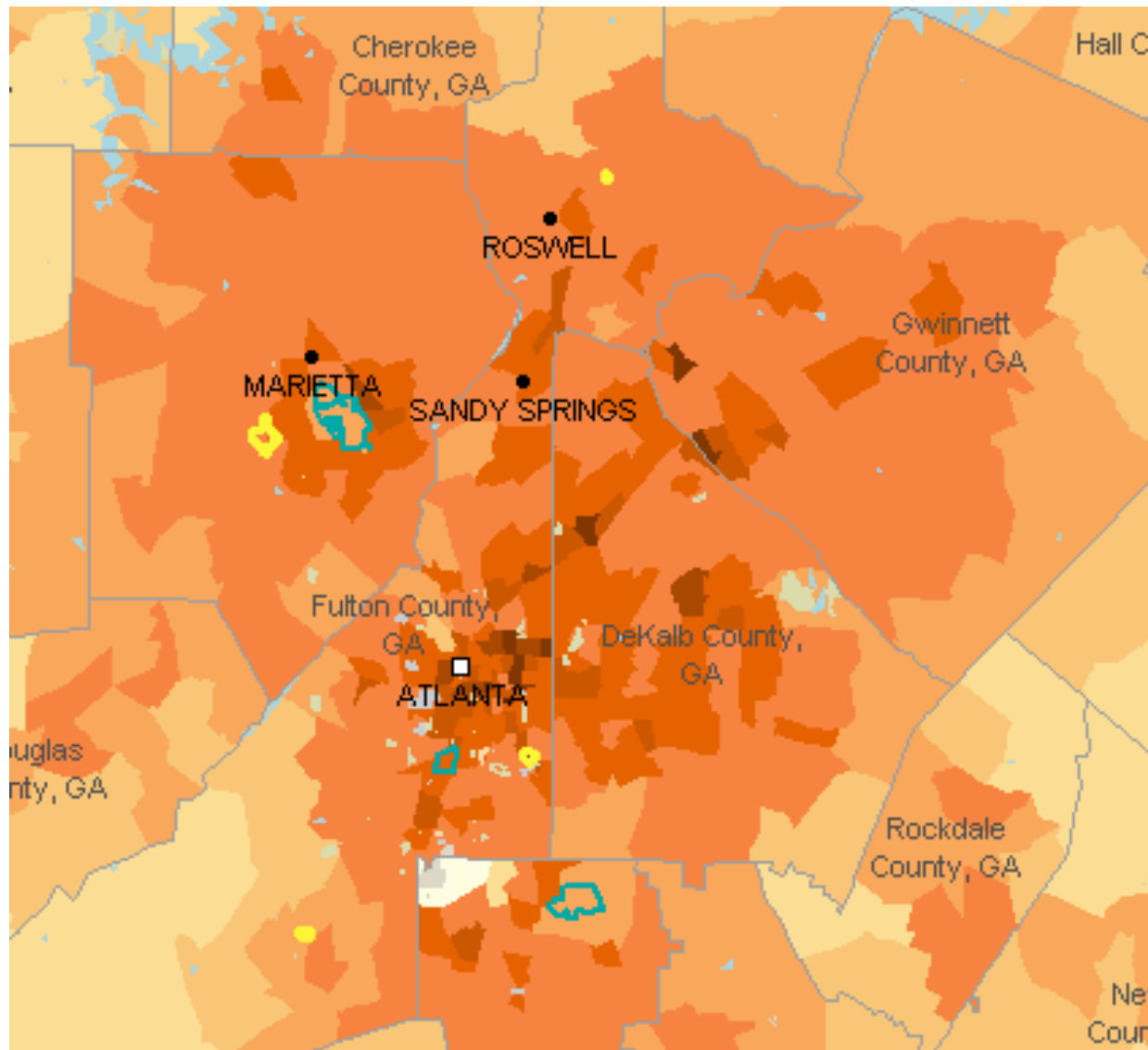

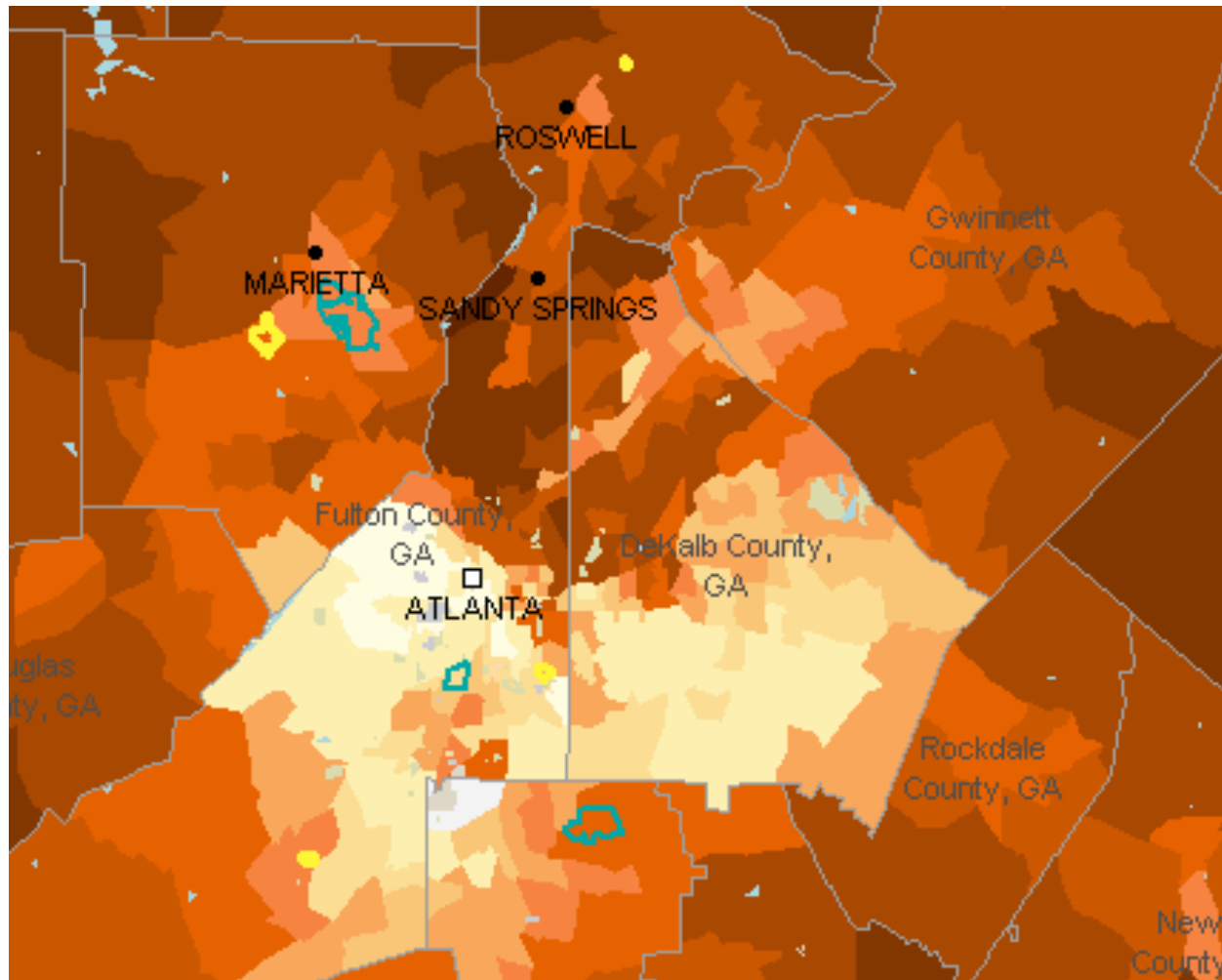
