2. Human Communication Research. Volume 40, Issue 1
3. This is a secondary source because they cite other research and use previous research in their writing.
4. This is intended for an academic or scholarly audience.
5. Credentials: PhD.
6. "Deception theory, judge expertise, and deception detection accuracy: Expertise has little impact on detection accuracy" "Expertise is moderated by lie stakes", "Wizards of deception detection"
7. The study's aim is to show that interactivity is not necessary for deception detection.
8. There are two hypotheses. The first one is that performance will be more similar to the situations facing experts will be significantly and substantially higher than that of non-experts. The second is that non-expert passive observers will have lower accuracy when judging expertly questioned senders.
