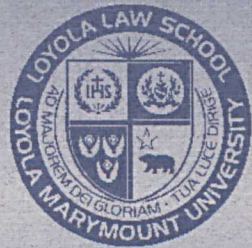

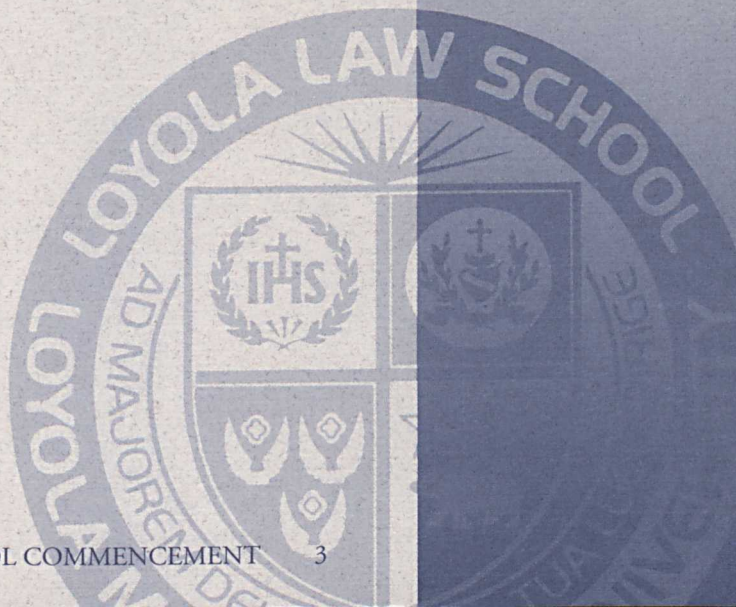

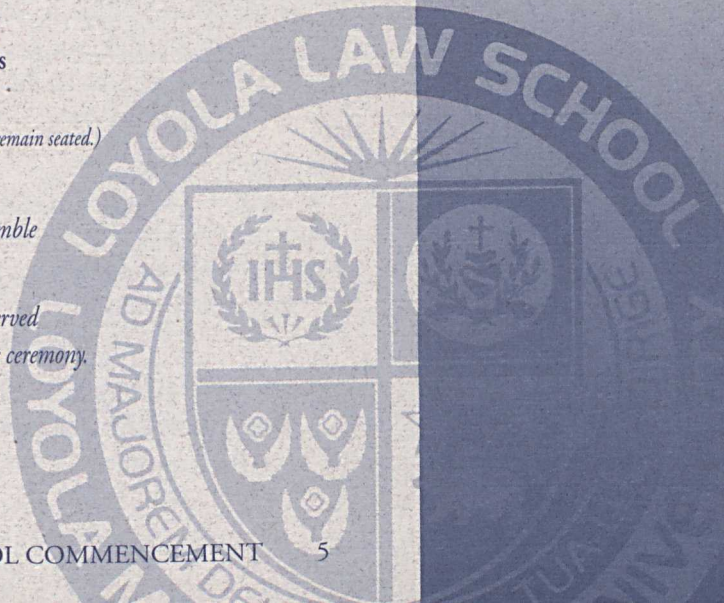

LLOYD TEVIS AWARD IN COMMERCIAL LAW

Established to honor the late Professor Lloyd Tevis '50, the seventh Dean of Loyola Law School and a beloved faculty member for 33 years, this award is bestowed upon a graduating student who has demonstrated outstanding achievement in the Commercial Law curriculum.

WILLIAM TELL AGGELER AWARD

Established in memory of the late William Tell Aggeler, a Superior Court of California judge and a former Loyola Law School professor, this award recognizes superior scholarship and exceptional academic achievement. It is given annually to the graduate with the highest grade point average.

ORDER OF THE COIF

In 1990, Loyola Law School was awarded a chapter in the prestigious Order of the Coif, the national legal honor society. The purpose of the Order of the Coif is to encourage excellence in legal education by fostering a spirit of careful study, and to recognize those who as law students achieved a high grade of scholarship. Students qualify by attaining a cumulative grade point average that places them within the top 10 percent of the class.

SCOTT MOOT COURT HONORS BOARD

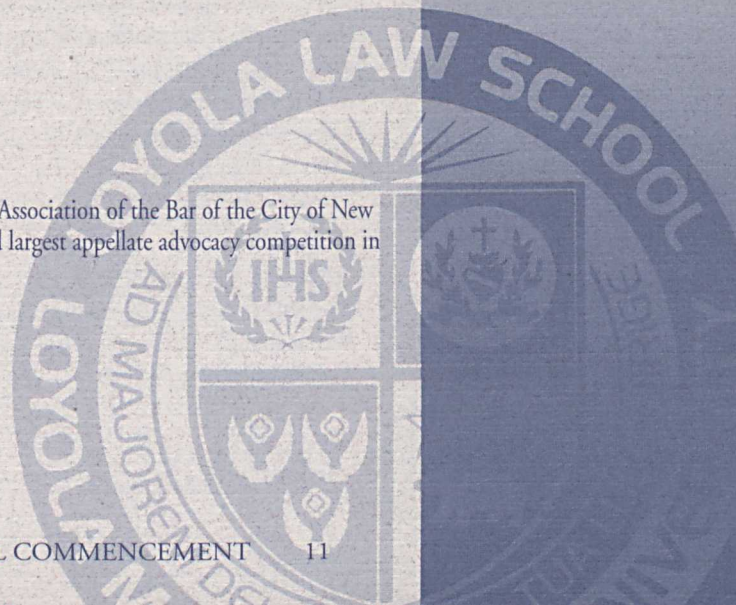

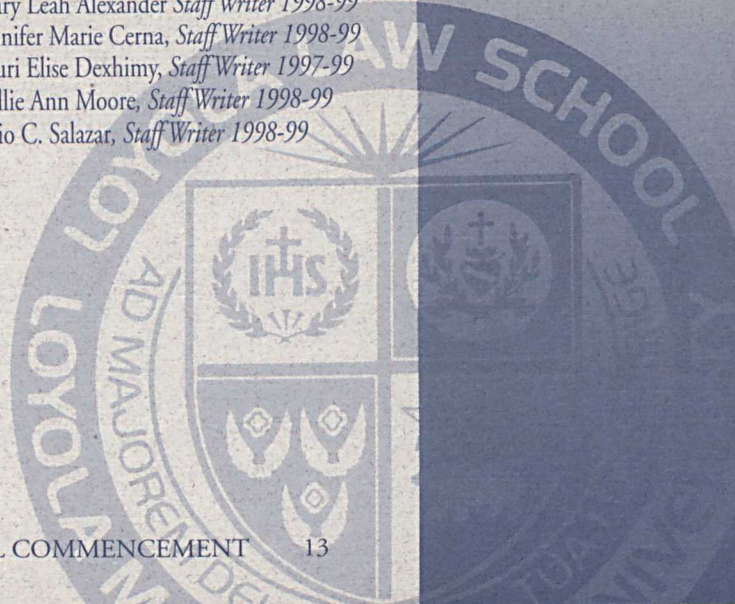
