

Laurel Way runs off N. Beverly Dr., one short block north of Lexington Dr. Once on Laurel Way, drive .4mi to a stop sign at a T-intersection. TURN LEFT at the stop sign. Drive .3 mi up winding street to another intersection where you TURN LEFT. This will keep you on Laurel Way. Do not go straight or you will start back down the hill. Drive .2mi to **1356 Laurel Way – 310 276-2801**
