
AND THEN SHE CONGRATULATED HERSELF ON HER BRILLIANCE WITH AN ICEE.






HER STUFFED BEAR SEEMED TO LOOK AT HER MOCKINGLY, JUDGING HER AS SHE CLOSED THE TAB.





AS THE CLASS PACKED UP AND OUT...





