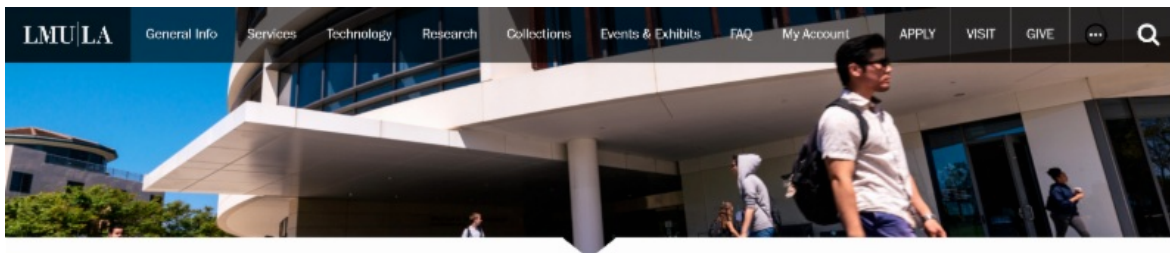

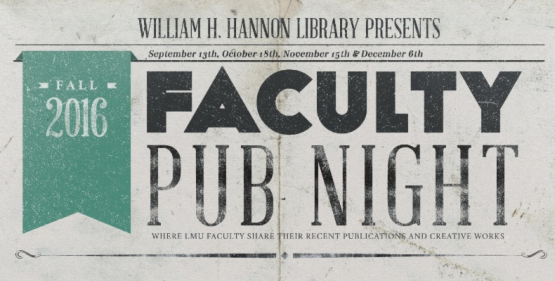


LMU Library Receives IMLS Grant

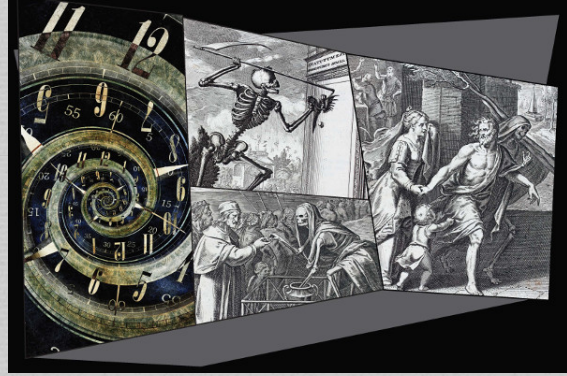
Sunday Jewish Book Group September 11, 2:00 - 3:30 P.M.

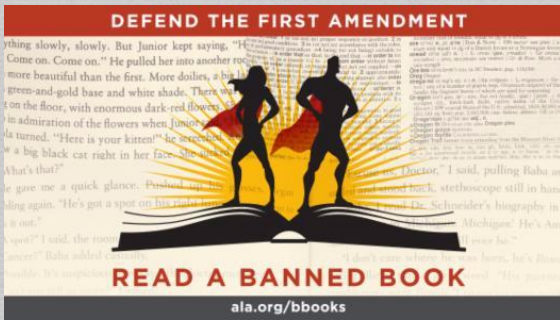
**Faculty Pub Night: Glenn Gebhard
